





What to Bring to DC

What to bring with you

Properties are furnished, including utilities, cable TV, wireless internet access, full kitchens, dishware, cookware and appliances (toaster, microwave, coffeepot, etc.), free laundry facilities (irons/ironing boards) and weekly and emergency maintenance. Furnishings also include access to WISH office and building management staff and 24-hour on-call emergency staffing, as well as social and professional development events.

BEDDING: Bring a full set of linens: pillows, blankets, sheets, and towels.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Laptop? Check. Smartphone? Double check.

What to wear

Business attire is a must for most work places. We have four seasons, and temperature ranges from hot and steamy in the summer to snow days in the winter. Dress for the right season.

Typically, interns are required to wear business clothes to work, but allow for days off and nightlife in your wardrobe.

The Metro system is everywhere!



WiSE Internship Program

WISH can help with internships too! The WiSE Internship Program puts students on the front lines of where public policy is made for all careers. When they return to campus life from this international city, they bring a new perspective to their studies and their classmates; they are determined to get their degrees.



About the WiSE Program

WisE is the Washington Intern Study Experience of a lifetime. The WISH Team works with students one-on-one to find them the internship that meets their goals.

WiSE integrates student housing, on-line home campus courses, intern placement and support, with career development that meets every school's academic, budgetary and inclusionary priorities.

WiSE is also available to university/ college partners who want to send students to Washington DC but may need placement assistance to do so.

Semester dates correspond with home campus academic semester. Intern in Washington, DC between 32-40 hours a week. WiSE staff works with the student on an individual basis from resume to interviews to placement. WiSE ensures internship requirements are met for the student's home campus.

Academic Credits vary depending upon university policies, but internships are designed to be 6-9 credits for the internship work. Live on Capitol Hill with WISH interns from all over the world in fully furnished WISH housing.

All WISH locations have WiFi, free laundry facilities, walking distance to the capitol buildings and are metro accessible. Take part in professional development and social events.

Summer Semester: January 30
Fall Semester: July 15

WiSE Internship Program Rates

The \$1,500 program fee provides your student with the WISH team who will work personally with your student to locate, prep, and get that internship opportunity. The team makes sure that school requirements of the internship are completed so credit is granted!

A semester in Washington DC is much less than a semester abroad and does not delay graduation. Call the WISH team so that your students can take advantage of this invaluable opportunity.
